

## Report of the Trustees for the year 2012

This report on the activities of Green Aid is for the year from 1 September 2011 to 31 August 2012.

This year our income was broadly the same as last year as were our activities

The principle fund raising activity is through the activities of our Chairman, Colin Green and other members and friends of the Green Family. Corporate donations come from companies in Israel and it is the charity's policy that funds donated by Israeli companies are used to support charitable causes in Israel

During the year we organised a fund raising concert with featuring the young violinist Itamar Rashkovsky, age 16 which raised £3,000. The money was distributed to the Yemin Orde Youth Village, The forgotten People's Fund which supports Ethiopian immigrants to Israel and Keshet Eilon which organises summer schools for young outstanding musicians from around the world. This year we have focused mainly on supporting disabled or disadvantaged groups of people, as well as educational, medical and humanitarian causes.. We made significant donations to the following charitable institutions:

We have thus made a large number of smaller donations to a wide range of charities, particularly supporting causes in Israel whose work is in fields relevant to our Objects.

Green Aid also administers the Antithesis Charitable Trust. This fund distributed CDs recorded specially for it by the artiste "Antithesis" with all the net sale proceeds being devoted to the objects of the Charity. To date, from the proceeds, donations of £2000 have been made to the United Jewish Israel Appeal and £1000 to the International Coalition for Missing Israeli Soldiers.
