## **Report of the Trustees for the year 2013**

This report on the activities of Green Aid is for the year from 1 September 2012 to 31 August 2013.

This year our income was slightly higher than last year and we were able to utilise some of our reserves to increase significantly the level of grants during the year

The principle fund raising activity is through the activities of our Chairman, Colin Green and other members and friends of the Green Family. Corporate donations come from companies in Israel and it is the charity's policy that funds donated by Israeli companies are used to support charitable causes in Israel.

This year we have focused mainly on supporting disabled or disadvantaged groups of people, as well as educational, medical and humanitarian causes.. The largest donation was to the Ha'emek Hospital in Afula to fund a breast imaging ultrasound room in the hospital. We visited the hospital during the year with some members of the Kingston Quaker Meeting, Kingston & Surbiton United Synagogue and Kingston Liberal Synagogue

We also made significant donations to the following charitable institutions:
